

NOW HIRING: JMC EDUCATOR



The John Marshall Center (JMC) is seeking a part-time Educator to conduct workshop activities in a partnership program between the JMC and John Marshall High School (JMHS). Over the course of the fall semester, the JMC/JMHS Educator will be responsible for delivering six curriculum modules on-site at JMHS for 12th grade Government students. The Educator will work closely with JMC Director of Education and JMHS faculty to refine lesson plans for curriculum modules, and maintain regular communication with JMC and JMHS about program deliverables. The Educator will also work closely with JMC staff to develop evaluation tools to assess program performance and generate suggestions for future iterations. This position is funded for the fall 2022 semester, which runs through January 2023.

Position type: Part-time, hourly

Weekly hours: Average 10 per week, to approximately 120 for project run. Additional hours may be available based on school needs.

Location: Richmond metro area (on-site at John Marshall High School and JMC offices, located at the Virginia Museum of History and Culture)

Required qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in History, Education, Museum Studies or related field.
- Experience working with high-school upperclassmen in an educational setting
- Ability to implement creative approaches when engaging with young audiences
- Proficiency in Office Suite, GSuite, and videoconferencing tools (Zoom, Skype, etc.)

Preferred qualifications:

- Current teacher's licensure
- Experience working with students in the Richmond Public School system
- Basic design abilities (Canva or similar platforms)
- Experience developing curricula for high school audiences
- Familiarity with Virginia Standards of Learning for U.S. Government course
